This 500-acre, open-air museum tells the story of Midwestern agriculture and rural life. Interpreters in period costumes recreate daily routines of early Iowans. Visit the 1700 Ioway Indian Farm, 1850 Pioneer Farm, 1875 Town, 1900 Horse-powered Farm and modern Exhibit Center. Many special events take place during the season (May - October) and historic dinners are offered November through March.
